


Figure 4.2: A flowchart showing the process of pre-operative assessment.

### Definitions

### Initial presentation

Initial presentation refers to a patient's first contact with a health professional, such as a GP, nurse or midwife, or a hospital consultant or receptionist. This contact may be planned or made as a result of symptoms experienced by the patient, or it may be part of the routine management of the patient's care. For example, patients attend for routine screening as shown in Table 4.1.

Initial presentation is often considered to be a consultation where the role of the healthcare professional is to elicit symptoms from a patient, eliciting history and symptoms, and then to explain what is wrong and what needs to be done. However, there are other types of initial presentation which help to identify the symptoms of a disease and may not fit under the concept of consultation.

### Assessment

The relationship between initial presentation and diagnosis is often described as being like the relationship between 'the tip of the iceberg' and 'the whole iceberg'. This means that only a small part of the problem is visible. There are techniques such as GPs' and GPs' self-assessment that can help to reduce the limitations of initial presentation. For example, a checklist of clinical signs and symptoms can be used to help to identify what might be wrong with a patient. This is helpful in the management of the patient because it helps to focus the mind of the doctor on what needs to be done.








Figure 10.22 Don't Be Deceived




